● Deep rip/cultivate (only compacted sites). Rip after autumn break when soil is dry for shattering, but moist enough to rip on the contour. For small-scale plantings dig individual planting holes by hand, rather than ripping.						●	●	●	◇	◇			
● Control weeds (using knockdown and/or residual herbicide 4 weeks prior planting or mulch seedlings in spring (after soil is warmed).						●	●	●	●	●	●	◇	◇
Plant Site (ensure seedlings are good quality, and water thoroughly before planting).													
● Hill sites or sites prone to drying out rapidly in spring.						◇	◇	●	●	●	◇
